DAVID MACFARLANE studied in both the church music and performance departments of the University for Performing Arts, Vienna. There, his teachers included Michael Radulescu (organ and improvisation), Gordon Murray (harpsichord) and masterclasses gave David the opportunity to work with other leading European musicians, including Ton Koopman, Luigi Ferdinando Tagliavini and Gerhard Schmidt-Gaden. In Vienna he was the Director of Music at Salvator am Wienerfeld where he officiated on the historically classified 1741 Dacci organ.

He is sought after as a continuo player of significant skill and stylistic sensitivity. His musical knowledge and ability is reflected in the range of music in which he is at home, from his expertise in the harpsichord, organ and choral music of the renaissance and baroque, through solo performances of the romantic organ repertoire, to championing new organ compositions.


